## Report on CSL 2024

Aniello Murano (co-chair with Alexandra Silva) delivers a brief report on the PC work of CSL'24.

- 33 PC members, 8 female and 25 male
- 60 people registered for CSL + workshops
- 20 people registered for the workshop FICS only
- Logic Mentoring Workshop [<https://logic-mentoring-workshop.github.io/csl24/>]: 10 speakers, around 20 participants (excluding organisers and speakers)
- 20 additional people participate to the conference (invited speakers, press & other)
- 88 submissions (106 abstract submissions)
- 42 accepted papers (4 paper withdrawn or desk rejected)
- around 50 talks
- Aniello mentioned about 100 participants at the "Industrial Table" organised during the last day.
- Proceedings published as in Leibniz International Proceedings in Informatics - 32nd EACSL Annual Conference on Computer Science Logic (CSL 2024)
- Winner of Helena Rasiowa Award for the best student paper at CSL'24: Quentin Aristote for the paper entitled "Active learning of deterministic transducers with outputs in arbitrary monoids"
